BLOG GUIDELINES

I have set up a blog for us at:

The purpose of this is for us to share our work more readily and with a wider audience, and to take full advantage of the world of digital media. After each assignment is completed, you will be required to post your pieces. Each of you is a contributor to the blog, and it is very easy to upload images by signing in, starting a new post, uploading your images, and clicking the publish button. Also, instead of writing artist statements as previously stated in your syllabus, you will be responsible to include a few sentences to a paragraph or so of explanation/background of the digital pieces you have created. This will act as your blog post with your uploaded images.

I have also posted our syllabus, various handouts and tutorials, and your assignments under the Links and Class Resources tab.

On top of posting your assignments, you will be required to make one other post every two weeks or so regarding the world of digital media. I would suggest googling digital art or just browsing the internet. Once you have found something you think is interesting, write a blog post and link to the web site you have found. Anything above once every two weeks will be considered extra credit. I would like this blog to become fairly interactive; we will go through the postings every so often and check out some digital art, design, web sites, etc. I will also be posting regularly to the site.

We will be going over how to apply a digital watermark for those of you who are concerned with copyright infringement. ALSO, please keep your posts appropriate; while I don't want to censor your work, keep in mind that this site represents our school and community, and I would like for it to be a place of inspiration and learning, not a place that may offend.

Check the blog frequently also for polls, contests, etc.
